«Developing and Communicating the ‘Aristotelistas’ Identity»

The Faculty of Economics and Political Sciences – ATh, within the framework of the celebrations of 2016 Aristotle Anniversary Year and the 90+ years of ATh, attempts to cultivate and develop to its community members and especially to its students, the identity of ‘Aristotelistas’.

The Creative Project entitled «Yes, I am an Aristotelistas!» in which students of the Faculty participate voluntarily, is designed to incorporate actions that will facilitate both the empathy of the ‘Aristotelistas’ identity and its communication, inside and outside of the ATh.

The objectives of the Creative Project «*Developing and Communicating the ‘Aristotelistas’ Identity*», that will be effectuated through interaction, life experiences and reflection, are:

- 1) the accentuation and acceptance of the Aristotelian principles and values and of those elements that could establish the identity of the ATh member; the ‘Aristotelistas’ identity. Student Volunteers of the Faculty, which are an integral part of this Creative Project and are acting under the scientific guidance of the Faculty members, will shape the core elements of the ‘Aristotelistas’ identity.
- 2) the cultivation and empathy of the Aristotelian principles and values to the Student Volunteers of the Faculty and participants of this Project, with the aim to empower them to further disseminate the idea to the university and academic community but also at local and national level. Thus, the creation of ambassadors of the ‘Aristotelistas’ identity and its impact on the scientific and social culture build in ATh are being undertaken.

This Creative Project runs throughout the year 2016 and will consist of various individual modular activities.

Starting, for the 2016 first-quarter of the celebration of the “Aristotle Anniversary Year”, with:

1. the participation of the Student Volunteers of the Faculty in: a) the ceremony of the lighting and handover of the Olympic Flame for the 2016 Olympic Games (21 April 2016, Ancient Olympia), and b) the Global March on the Sacred Way entitled ‘The Athletes’ Road to Glory’ (20 – 21/04/2016).
2. the participation of the Student Volunteers of the Faculty in the celebrations of the 2016 Aristotle Anniversary Year and the 90+ years of ATh communicating, in various ways, the ‘Aristotelistas’ identity. Particular will be their presence in the World Congress ‘Aristotle 2.400 Years’ organized by ATh (23 – 28/05/2016).
